## **Old Business:**

## **New Business:**

June 20 Match or training session.

First, we have scheduled an action pistol match for 20 June, should this be a match or a training session? I see 3 possible alternatives. 1) Hold a simple action match, 2) Hold an 'action' type training/practice session with emphasis on speed reloads and drawing from a holster and 3) Repeat the 'qualification match' with times/scores unchanged for unqual. members and with "comstock" scoring for qualified members. "Comstock" scoring places an emphasis on speed with the score being the raw target score divided by the time required to shoot it - if it took a shooter 20 seconds to shoot a stage and he got a raw score of 75 his score would be  $75/20 = 3.75$  If he shot it in 15 seconds and scored only 60, score would be  $60/15 = 4!$  Any of these options will require that we emphasize the need for holsters.

November Fund Raiser

It is time to start planning for a Nov. fund raiser, suggest we form committees for a) event planning, b) fund raising and c) publicity (and/or any other you think we need. Suggest we spend the summer months planning what we need to do and be ready to start actively working in early September for a 7 Nov. event.
